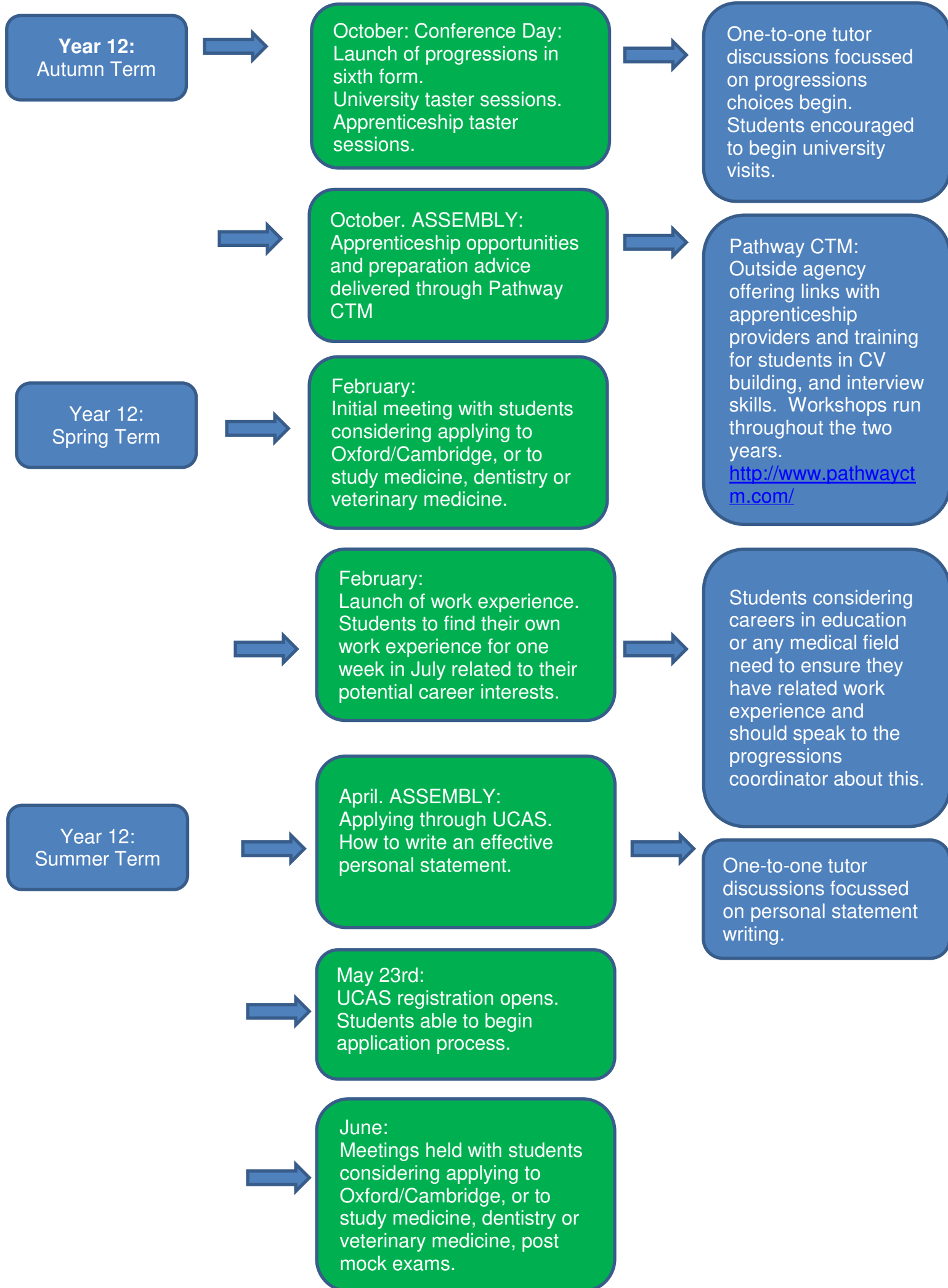


Sixth Form Progressions Schedule.





June:
Students applying to Oxford/Cambridge, or to study medicine, dentistry or veterinary medicine meet with progressions tutor to discuss personal statement writing and entrance exams.



July 10th:
Week of work experience begins.
Tutors to arrange visits/conversations with students and employers.



SUMMER BREAK:
ALL students to write personal statement for UCAS, international universities or CVs.



September: Mock entrance tests for students applying to Oxford/Cambridge, or to study medicine.



September 15th: Internal deadline for applying to Oxford/Cambridge, or to study medicine. (UCAS Oct 15th)

→ June 22nd: UCAS. If you have received all of your offers by June 8th, you **must** respond with choices by this date.

→ July 4th: UCAS. If you have been unsuccessful in your application, this is your last date to apply to another institution through EXTRA.

→ The progressions coordinator will meet with eligible students to talk through these.

→ July 5th: UCAS. Clearing opens.

→ July 5th: IB Results released.

→ The progressions coordinator and head of sixth form will be available to advice on progressions options.

→ 18th August: A Level results released.
